Afterward, enjoy a breakfast from a local café, then find a quiet spot by the waterfront to bask in the tranquil, yet equally wild and natural untouched setting.

This morning you will rediscover yourself and dive into the untouched underwater world of the wild west coast with a 2-hour guided scuba dive with Coffin Bay Scuba Co. Here you are likely to encounter seahorses, octopus, and rays in their natural habitat.

After a warm shower and some downtime, it's time to sample the wild west coast edible experience with a luxurious oyster feast at Oyster HQ, Coffin Bay's premium waterfront dining venue. Savour the ocean's bounty with the freshest oysters and a selection of hand-picked tapas, perfect for sharing as you gaze over the pristine bay.

Wanting some oysters to go? Make sure you visit HQ's oyster vending machine, the only one of its kind in Australia!

In the afternoon, embark on the "Experience Coffin Bay" tour boat for a 1.5-hour journey into the water leases which are the heart of oyster farming, departing from the Yacht Club floating jetty. Immerse yourself in the wild and learn the origins and delicate process of oyster cultivation, enjoying tales from a veteran farmer alongside tasting oysters plucked straight from the waters – they don't get any fresher than this!

With some free time, this is your moment to unwind and sync with the rhythm of Coffin Bay's mesmerising, coastal atmosphere. If exploring is more your thing, then take a short drive to the beautiful Coffin Bay National Park.

Conclude your wild adventure with a sumptuous dinner at 1802 Oyster Bar where you will enjoy the finest local seafood amidst the spectacular, raw and romantic backdrop of the setting sun over Coffin Bay.
